

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE MEETING OF THE DISTRICT LEVEL**  
**CO-ORDINATION & SELECTION COMMITTEE HELD ON THE 12<sup>th</sup> FEBRUARY 2016 AT THE**  
**CONFERENCE ROOM OF THE OFFICE OF THE DEPUTY COMMISSIONER WEST JAINTIA HILLS**  
**DISTRICT, JOWAI**

**Members Present: - As per Annexure**

The meeting was chaired by Shri. Arunkumar Kembhavi, IAS, Deputy Commissioner-cum- Chairman District Level Co-ordination & Selection Committee (DLC&SC) West Jaintia Hills District who at the very outset welcomed all members present and informed them the purpose of the meeting which was for selection and approval of schemes under Special Central Assistance (Border Areas Development Programme) SCA(BADP) during the year 2016-17. The Chairman then asked the Member-Secretary to read out the proceedings of the meeting of the DLC&SC of the previous year held on the 13<sup>th</sup> April 2015. The Member-Secretary also informed the members that for the year 2016-17, an amount of `182.50 Lakhs has been allocated for West Jaintia Hills District under SCA(BADP) out of which `115.8875 Lakhs has been earmarked for fresh schemes, `18.250 Lakhs for Security Related Schemes, `27.3750 Lakhs for Maintenance of Assets, `2.7375 Lakhs for Monitoring Evaluation and `18.250 Lakhs for Skill Development in the border areas. The Member-Secretary also read out the various pertinent points extracted from the latest Revised Guidelines on BADP (June 2015).

Before going into threadbare discussion, the Chairman asked the Member-Secretary if any village has been saturated to which the Member-Secretary replied that by the general definition of saturation of a village as per guidelines, no village has been saturated so far. He also informed the members about BADP of not being a main scheme rather it could act as a supplement to different types of schemes and meant only to fill the critical gaps. When asked by the Chairman whether a baseline survey for all the strategic villages has been conducted, the member secretary replied in affirmation. The Chairman also enquired if any interest accumulated out of BADP fund to which the BADO, Dawki replied in the negative as account was recently changed from the current account to savings account. The Chairman also informed the members that as per guidelines, any type of earthwork which can be taken up under MNREGA cannot be taken up under BADP. The Chairman also informed that all the sectors have minimum and maximum ceiling which should not ideally be crossed under BADP guidelines. After placing the proposal before the members, the Chairman asked different line departments if they have any proposals.

1. The D.A.O. Jowai from Agriculture department informed the members about a need for construction of a Community Threshing Yard in the border area and also briefed the importance of having one.

2. The D.S.E.O. Jowai from Education department put up proposals for improvement of science laboratory for 17 nos. of schools and development of playfields for 19 nos. of schools in the border areas.
3. The Addl. D.M.H.O. Jowai from Health Department informed the members about the shortage of medical equipments in Dawki PHC and Nongtalang CHC. He proposed a dental chair, dental equipments and an ambulance for Nongtalang PHC and also a dental X-ray, dental chair and an ambulance at Dawki PHC to be included under BADP.
4. The A.C.F. (S/F) Jowai of Forest Department proposed for construction of Children's Park in the border area.
5. On the proposed construction of drip irrigation project for Krampoi Amplung Farmer Committee at Nongtalang, the Asstt Director Horticulture asked whether the irrigation would be traditional or modern method and also the crop to be irrigated as according to her, the proposed amount would be too meager. The BADO Dawki clarified that the proposed scheme would be an extension of the existing traditional irrigation of betel leaves.
6. The representative of the Border Security Force informed the members about the dilapidated condition of the road from Dawki to Muktapur and so also the road from Muktapur to Hawaii Tilla. He also stressed the need of connecting pipelines from water source to Hawaii Tilla because of the shortage of water supply in Hawaii Tilla.
7. The Asstt Director, BAD –cum- Member-Secretary informed the members that electrification of Syndai cave was sanctioned under SCA (BADP) in the year 1998-99 which at present has been completely out of order and that the same could be taken up under maintenance of assets fund in order to promote tourism. The Committee however felt that since it has been completely out of order the same can be taken up as fresh scheme and that 10% contribution should be borne by the Manner Clan since the cave is under the management of the Clan.
8. The representative from Non Conventional Energy proposed for setting up 10 units solar street lights along with life jackets and other amenities at Shnongpdeng village to which the committee agreed on condition that 10% contribution should be borne by the inhabitants of the village.

9. Dy Superintendent of Police, Jowai informed the members that the department has a Patrol Post at Dawki in a two-storeyed building constructed by MGCC which at present is in dilapidated condition and proposed for renovation of the same. However the Committee did not consider taking it up under BADP as the guidelines do not permit for the same.

The Committee after hearing the proposals from different departments agreed to select only few of them due to less allocation of fund. The proposals selected are:-

- i) Purchase of ambulance for Dawki PHC at Dawki Bakur- `6.00 Lakhs. As a mini ambulance costs more than 6 lakhs, the Chairman informed that the remaining fund will be pooled in from other sources.
- ii) Purchase of dental equipments and other medical equipments and improving existing amenities in Nongtalang CHC at Nongtalang-`.5.00 Lakhs
- iii) Provision of laboratory equipments for 7(seven) nos. of schools in the border area @ 75,000-`.5.25 Lakhs
- iv) Improvement of Syndai Cave including electrification at Syndai village-`.5.00 Lakhs. 10% of the overall sanctioned amount to be borne by the clan.
- v) Provision of 10 units of Solar street lights @`.30,000 (`3.00 Lakhs), Life jackets and other tourism amenities at Shnongpdeng village (`2.00 Lakhs)-`.5.00 Lakhs

To adjust with the above selected schemes, the committee decided to omit some schemes that featured in the prepared list of proposed schemes viz.

- i) Construction of RCC footbridge over Wah Maskein at Jarain-`.5.00 Lakhs
- ii) Construction of RCC footbridge at Amtasu, Jarain-`.5.00 Lakhs
- iii) Construction of Community House near crematorium and Improvement of Community Hall at Amjalong-`.5.00 Lakhs
- iv) Construction of road from Pdengshakap-Trsnngblang to Lukha at Pdengshakap -`.6.00 Lakhs
- v) Improvement of playground for Tympang club at Nongtalang-`.5.00 Lakhs

The Chairman also informed the members that additional fund may be available before the end of financial year due to surrendering/non-utilisation from different states and also 5% discretionary funds available with the Union Home Secretary (Border Management). Efforts will be made to avail funds and major schemes will be considered for inclusion before the end of the financial year. Regret was conveyed to the Executive Engineer Jowai South Division who had proposed a causeway on Muktapur Borghat Road where people get stranded during rainy season as the amount sought was very high, 30 lakhs. The Chairman assured the EE that it will be taken up in due course of time.
